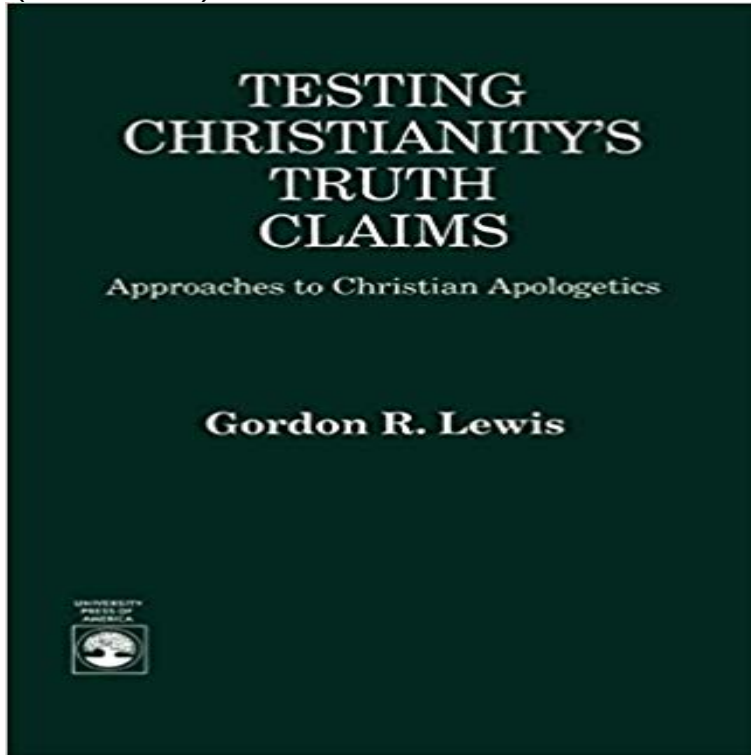


Testing Christianity's Truth Claims: Approaches to Christian Apologetics (Sciences)
