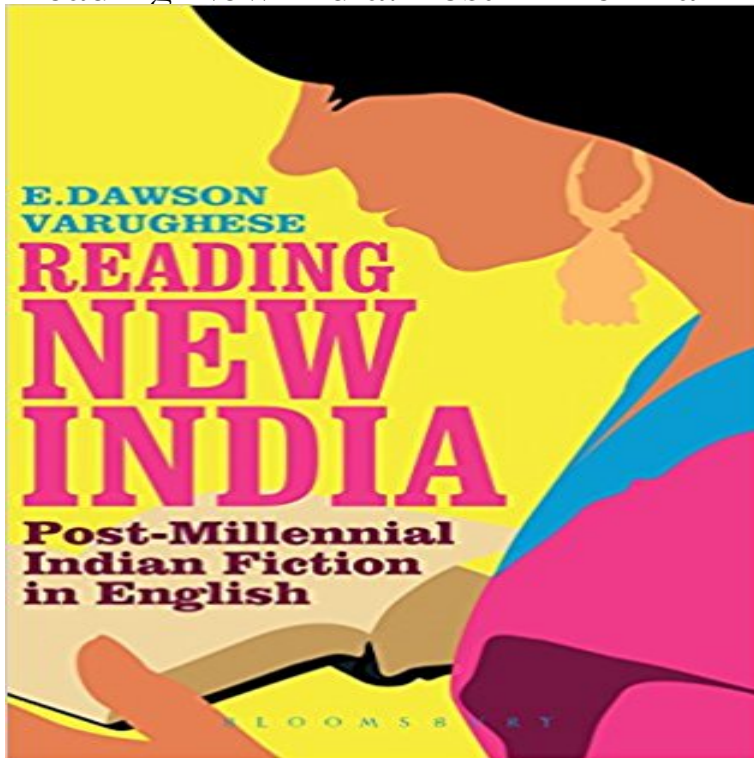


Reading New India: Post-Millennial Indian Fiction in English
