If for a time the light of His countenance is withdrawne, who am I, the poorest of His Creatures, that I mould complaine, if my path, when it seemeth to Him good, should bee through the darke valley of Humiliation; so I walked sorrowfully on my way, uncomforted from within or from without; thought on the text, In thy afflictions He is afflicted, and the Angel of his Presence saveth thee, but this comfort seemed not intended for mee. Begin to doubt, that I have beene too readie to bee satisfied with myself, and to say to my soule Peace, peace, where there is no peace, and have not beene so contrite and broken under a sense of Sinne; and so is it not unrepented Sinne which doth stand betweene mee and the light of my Fathers Countenance?
