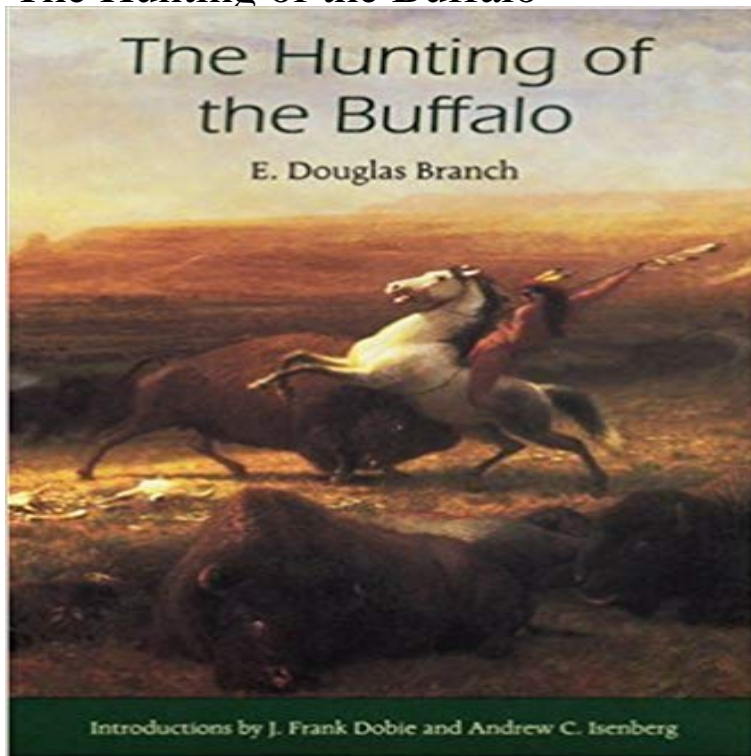


The Hunting of the Buffalo
