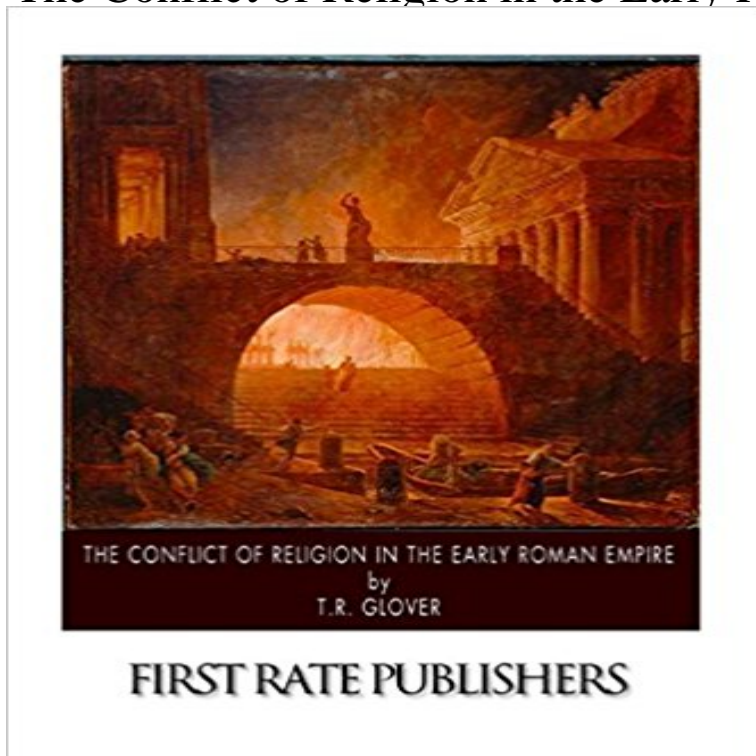


The Conflict of Religion in the Early Roman Empire
