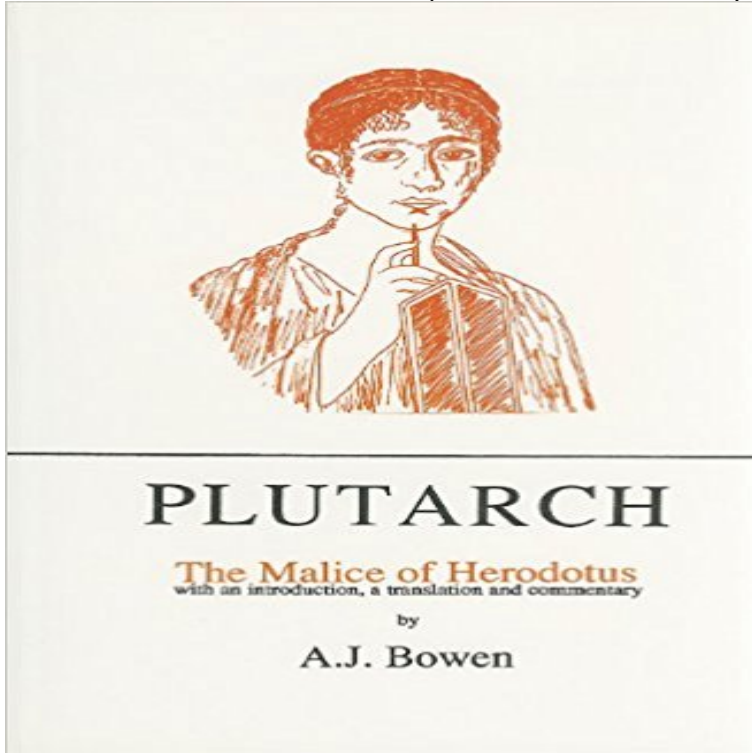


Malice of Herodotus (Classical Texts) (Ancient Greek Edition)



The Malice of Herodotus can perhaps best be described as the worlds earliest known book review. But it is much more than that, for in the course of correcting with considerable vituperation what he saw as Herodotus anti-Greek bias, Plutarch tells us much about his own attitude to writing history. So that together with Lucians How to Write History (see Lucian A Selection in this series) it forms a basic text for the study of Greek historiography. It is also perhaps the most revealing example of Plutarchs prose style with its rhetorical variety and energy and odd mixture of good and bad argument. But in citing lost works, Plutarch has preserved valuable fragments which dont exist elsewhere and need to be assessed by all students of the Persian Wars.
