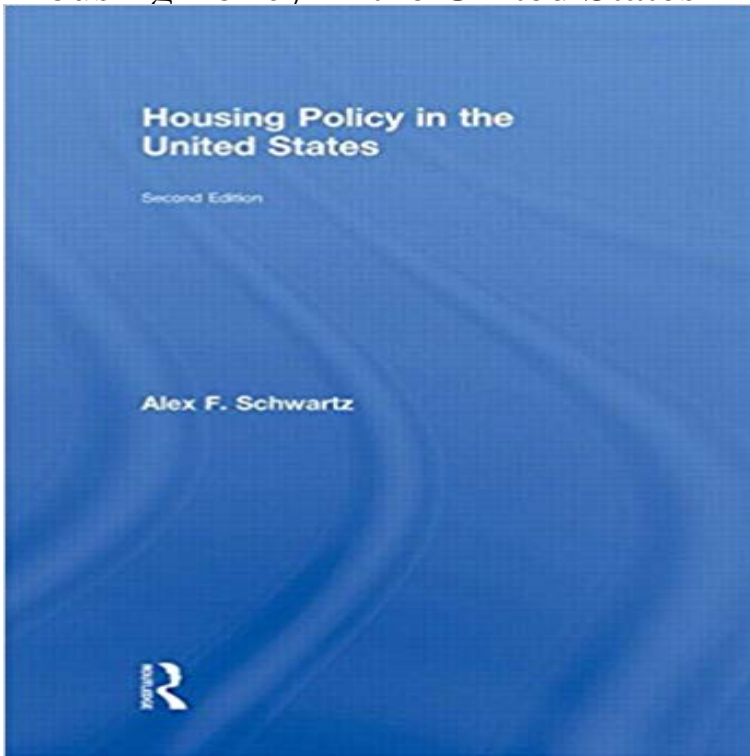


# Housing Policy in the United States
