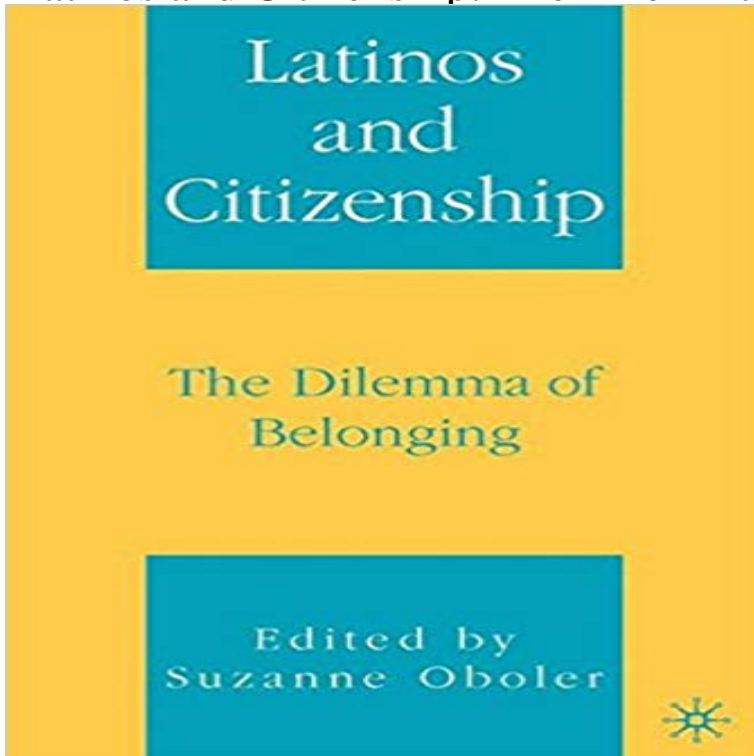


Latinos and Citizenship: The Dilemma of Belonging
