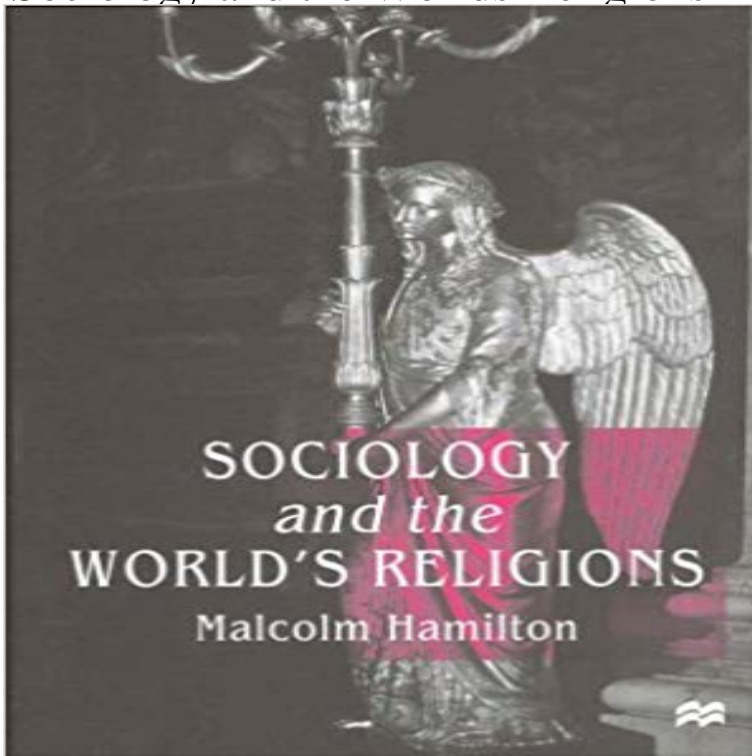


Sociology and the Worlds Religions
